GRADING SHOWJUMPING AND EVENTING - Explained

The difference between Showjumping and Eventing for grading purposes is mainly height. The levels are **not comparative** and there has been confusion over this. Showjumping grading is referred to in letters - ie A grade. In Eventing, the levels are graded with numbers - ie Gr 1. The heights are very different, with the lowest level in showjumping (E grade) going to a maximum of 76cm. The lowest level for eventing (Gr 5) has a maximum of 45cm. And so it is through all grades. Please bear this in mind when approaching panel to be graded.
